Hello Striders!! First – thanks to everyone that filled out our survey. We got some great feedback.

It's that time of year – – we will be holding our **2021 Blacksburg Striders Annual Meeting on Wednesday, November 17th at 7:15 pm at Runabout** (after the pub run), and will have a virtual option for those that cannot or would prefer not to attend in person. For those in person, we will be providing pizza post run, and you're welcome to bring a beverage to enjoy.

We'll keep this as short as possible: the purpose (1) an update from the President on what Striders has done for the past year, and (2) to nominate and elect executive board members. We plan for this meeting to run for less than 45 minutes -- hope to wrap up by 8pm.

Details below on the four primary board seats. You can **reply to this email with nominations** for those seats, or for additional volunteer roles. Dues paying members can vote at our meeting (in person and virtually). In addition to President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, we are looking for volunteers to participate as at-large board members in any of the following areas: Social Media (lead our facebook and instagram presence), website design, membership, social run leaders, or if you have an idea for other areas of focus.

As a reminder, our four primary board seats are (and in red are suggested edits from deviating from our bylaws)

President — to preside over meetings, represent this association with the RRCA, to call any special meetings, and to appoint committees and chairpersons thereof with approval from the Board.

Vice-President — to assume the powers of the president in his/her absence, and to take on special assignments as requested by the president. **To serve as liaison with RRCA and race directors for races with which the Striders are affiliated.**

Secretary — to record minutes at all meetings in accordance with Roberts Rules of Order, to keep a file of such minutes, oversee the election process for all board members, and, when requested by the president, to accept assignments involving correspondence and the keeping of records.

Treasurer - Oversee the budget planning process, ensure adequate income available to achieve the budgeted expenses, safeguard the organizations assets, draft financial policies for board approval, anticipate and report financial problems, ensure the board receives regular and accurate financial statements and that the board members understand the information presented, ensure federal, state, and local reporting takes place, and other duties as requested by the president.
